YPAC REQUIREMENTS:

- Age of 40 or younger
- Willing to promote all YP happenings via word of mouth and social media
- Willing and able to provide constructive feedback to help further shape and improve the YP Program
- Commit to attending up to 8 one-hour long virtual meetings
- Applicants must also have committed support from their supervisor/manager to serve in this leadership role
- Commitment: 1 year, however with Manager approval, they can apply for a second year. Participation is NOT guaranteed.
