



IMMEDIATE ACTION REQUESTED : Vote YES on S. 2155

For the past year we've been working hard to promote the Campaign for Common-Sense Regulation. It now appears that the US Senate will vote upon S. 2155 this week (March 6-8, 2018). As of last week, both Senators Durbin and Duckworth were reviewing the bill and had not taken a formal position on the measure. The timing is right for you to contact them to vote YES on S. 2155.

S. 2155 – the Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief, & Consumer Protection Act provides the perfect bi-partisan solution to help ease the regulatory burden small financial institutions like credit unions face. Credit union members will benefit directly from this bill's passage through increased protections from elder abuse for seniors, and a simpler and quicker mortgage process, and better access to affordable housing in our local communities. Additionally, your credit union will be able to allocate more of your time to serving members than working on compliance.

If S. 2155 passes, the regulatory burden you are facing will be decreased and your members will benefit from greater member service.

The Senate is expected to vote on S. 2155 this week and we need you to do the following:
